AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 18, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 6; RELATING TO PERSONAL INFORMATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 18, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 18-601. Data collection; personal information; access

8 A. ANY COMMERCIAL OR BUSINESS WEBSITE THAT COLLECTS PERSONAL
9 INFORMATION FROM ANY PERSON AND THAT HAS MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED USERS OR
10 PERSONAL ACCOUNTS SHALL ESTABLISH A PERSONAL INFORMATION PORTAL. THE
11 PERSONAL INFORMATION PORTAL MUST BE A SECURE ONLINE WEBSITE THAT ALLOWS A
12 PERSON TO ACCESS THE PERSON'S COLLECTED PERSONAL INFORMATION AND TO
13 CORRECT ANY ERROR IN THE PERSON'S PERSONAL INFORMATION.

14 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, WEBSITE DOES NOT INCLUDE A
15 WEBSITE THAT IS OPERATED BY A STATE AGENCY.
