A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; REPEALING ARTICLE IV, PART 2, SECTION 6, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO PRIVILEGE FROM ARREST AND CIVIL PROCESS.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,  
2 the Senate concurring:

3 1. Article IV, part 2, section 6, Constitution of Arizona, is  
4 proposed to be repealed as follows if approved by the voters and on  
5 proclamation of the Governor:

6 Article IV, part 2, section 6, Constitution of Arizona,  
7 relating to privilege from arrest and civil process, is  
8 repealed.

9 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the  
10 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,  
11 Constitution of Arizona.
