AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION THE SUPERINTENDENT OF  
PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Reduction in school district state aid  
3 apportionment in fiscal year 2019-2020;  
4 appropriation in fiscal year 2020-2021; intent

5 A. In addition to any other appropriation reductions made in fiscal  
6 year 2019-2020, notwithstanding any other law, the department of education  
7 shall defer until after June 30, 2020 but not later than July 12, 2020  
8 \$630,727,700 of the basic state aid and additional state aid payments that  
9 otherwise would be apportioned to school districts during fiscal year  
10 2019-2020 pursuant to section 15-973, Arizona Revised Statutes. The  
11 funding deferral required by this subsection does not apply to charter  
12 schools or to school districts with a student count of less than six  
13 hundred pupils. The department of education shall make the deferral by  
14 reducing the apportionment of state aid for each month in the fiscal year  
15 by the same amount.

16 B. In addition to any other appropriations made in fiscal year  
17 2020-2021, the sum of \$630,727,700 is appropriated from the state general  
18 fund in fiscal year 2020-2021 to the department of education and the  
19 superintendent of public instruction for basic state aid and additional  
20 state aid entitlement for fiscal year 2020-2021. This appropriation shall  
21 be disbursed after June 30, 2020 but not later than July 12, 2020 to the  
22 several counties for the school districts in each county in amounts equal  
23 to the reductions in apportioning basic state aid and additional state aid  
24 that are required pursuant to subsection A of this section for fiscal year  
25 2019-2020.

26 C. Each school district shall include in the revenue estimate it  
27 uses to compute its tax rate for fiscal year 2019-2020 the monies it will  
28 receive pursuant to subsection B of this section.

29 D. The legislature intends that monies for any remaining amounts  
30 for existing reductions in apportioning basic state aid and additional  
31 state aid will be appropriated and disbursed not later than July 12, 2022.
