1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona: Section 1. Section 28-101, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by 2 3 Laws 2018, chapter 9, section 1, chapter 163, section 1, chapter 166, 4 section 1, chapter 306, section 1 and chapter 324, section 1, is amended 5 to read: 6 28-101. <u>Definitions</u> 7 In this title, unless the context otherwise requires: 8 1. "Alcohol" means any substance containing any form of alcohol, 9 including ethanol, methanol, propynol and isopropynol. 10 2. "Alcohol concentration" if expressed as a percentage means 11 either: 12 (a) The number of grams of alcohol per one hundred milliliters of 13 blood. 14 (b) The number of grams of alcohol per two hundred ten liters of 15 breath. 3. "All-terrain vehicle" means either of the following: 16 17 (a) A motor vehicle that satisfies all of the following: 18 (i) Is designed primarily for recreational nonhighway all-terrain 19 travel. 20 (ii) Is fifty or fewer inches in width. 21 (iii) Has an unladen weight of one thousand two hundred pounds or 22 less. 23 (iv) Travels on three or more nonhighway tires. 24 (v) Is operated on a public highway. 25 (b) A recreational off-highway vehicle that satisfies all of the 26 following: 27 (i) Is designed primarily for recreational nonhighway all-terrain 28 travel. 29 (ii) Is eighty or fewer inches in width. 30 (iii) Has an unladen weight of two thousand five hundred pounds or 31 less. 32 (iv) Travels on four or more nonhighway tires. 33 (v) Has a steering wheel for steering control. 34 (vi) Has a rollover protective structure. 35 (vii) Has an occupant retention system. 36 4. "Authorized emergency vehicle" means any of the following: 37 (a) A fire department vehicle. 38 (b) A police vehicle. 39 (c) An ambulance or emergency vehicle of a municipal department or 40 public service corporation that is designated or authorized by the department or a local authority. 41 (d) Any other ambulance, fire truck or rescue vehicle that is 42 43 authorized by the department in its sole discretion and that meets 44 liability insurance requirements prescribed by the department.

5. "Autocycle" means a three-wheeled motorcycle on which the driver and passengers ride in a fully or partially enclosed seating area that is equipped with a roll cage, safety belts for each occupant and antilock brakes and that is designed to be controlled with a steering wheel and pedals.

6. "Aviation fuel" means all flammable liquids composed of a 7 mixture of selected hydrocarbons expressly manufactured and blended for 8 the purpose of effectively and efficiently operating an internal 9 combustion engine for use in an aircraft but does not include fuel for jet 10 or turbine powered aircraft.

11 7. "Bicycle" means a device, including a racing wheelchair, that is 12 propelled by human power and on which a person may ride and that has 13 either:

14 (a) Two tandem wheels, either of which is more than sixteen inches 15 in diameter.

16 (b) Three wheels in contact with the ground, any of which is more 17 than sixteen inches in diameter.

18

8. "Board" means the transportation board.

9. "Bus" means a motor vehicle designed for carrying sixteen or
 more passengers, including the driver.

10. "Business district" means the territory contiguous to and including a highway if there are buildings in use for business or industrial purposes within any six hundred feet along the highway, including hotels, banks or office buildings, railroad stations and public buildings that occupy at least three hundred feet of frontage on one side or three hundred feet collectively on both sides of the highway.

27 11. "Certificate of ownership" means a paper or an electronic
28 record that is issued in another state or a foreign jurisdiction and that
29 indicates ownership of a vehicle.

30 12. "Certificate of title" means a paper document or an electronic 31 record that is issued by the department and that indicates ownership of a 32 vehicle.

13. "Combination of vehicles" means a truck or truck tractor and semitrailer and any trailer that it tows but does not include a forklift designed for the purpose of loading or unloading the truck, trailer or semitrailer.

37 14. "Controlled substance" means a substance so classified under 38 section 102(6) of the controlled substances act (21 United States Code 39 section 802(6)) and includes all substances listed in schedules I through 40 V of 21 Code of Federal Regulations part 1308.

41

15. "Conviction" means:

42 (a) An unvacated adjudication of guilt or a determination that a
43 person violated or failed to comply with the law in a court of original
44 jurisdiction or by an authorized administrative tribunal.

1 (b) An unvacated forfeiture of bail or collateral deposited to 2 secure the person's appearance in court. 3 (c) A plea of guilty or no contest accepted by the court. 4 (d) The payment of a fine or court costs. "County highway" means a public road that is constructed and 5 16. 6 maintained by a county. 7 17. "Dealer" means a person who is engaged in the business of 8 buying, selling or exchanging motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers and 9 who has an established place of business and has paid fees pursuant to 10 section 28-4302. 11 18. "Department" means the department of transportation acting 12 directly or through its duly authorized officers and agents. 19. "Digital network or software application" has the same meaning 13 14 prescribed in section 28-9551. 20. "Director" 15 the of means director the department of 16 transportation. 17 21. "Drive" means to operate or be in actual physical control of a 18 motor vehicle. 19 22. "Driver" means a person who drives or is in actual physical 20 control of a vehicle. 21 "Driver license" means a license that is issued by a state to 23. 22 an individual and that authorizes the individual to drive a motor vehicle. 23 24. "Electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is equipped 24 with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of less than seven 25 hundred fifty watts and that meets the requirements of one of the 26 following classes: 27 (a) "Class 1 electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is 28 equipped with an electric motor that provides assistance only when the 29 rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle 30 or tricycle reaches the speed of twenty miles per hour. 31 (b) "Class 2 electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is 32 equipped with an electric motor that may be used exclusively to propel the 33 bicycle or tricycle and that is not capable of providing assistance when 34 the bicycle or tricycle reaches the speed of twenty miles per hour. 35 (c) "Class 3 electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is 36 equipped with an electric motor that provides assistance only when the 37 rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle 38 or tricycle reaches the speed of twenty-eight miles per hour. 39 "Electric personal assistive mobility device" 25. means а 40 self-balancing device with one wheel or two nontandem wheels and an electric propulsion system that limits the maximum speed of the device to 41 fifteen miles per hour or less and that is designed to transport only one 42 43 person. "Evidence" includes both of the following: 44 26.

1 (a) A display on wireless communication device of а а department-generated driver license, nonoperating identification license, 2 3 vehicle registration card or other official record of the department that 4 presented to a law enforcement officer or in a court or is an 5 administrative proceeding.

6 (b) An electronic or digital license plate authorized pursuant to 7 section 28-364.

8 27. "Farm" means any lands primarily used for agriculture 9 production.

10 28. "Farm tractor" means a motor vehicle designed and used 11 primarily as a farm implement for drawing implements of husbandry.

12 29. "Foreign vehicle" means a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer 13 that is brought into this state other than in the ordinary course of 14 business by or through a manufacturer or dealer and that has not been 15 registered in this state.

16 30. "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that has not less than three 17 wheels in contact with the ground, that has an unladen weight of less than 18 one thousand eight hundred pounds, that is designed to be and is operated 19 at not more than twenty-five miles per hour and that is designed to carry 20 not more than four persons including the driver.

21 31. "Hazardous material" means a material, and its mixtures or 22 solutions, that the United States department of transportation determines 23 under 49 Code of Federal Regulations is, or any quantity of a material 24 listed as a select agent or toxin under 42 Code of Federal Regulations 25 part 73 that is, capable of posing an unreasonable risk to health, safety and property if transported in commerce and that is required to be 26 27 placarded or marked as required by the department's safety rules 28 prescribed pursuant to chapter 14 of this title.

29 32. "Implement of husbandry" means a vehicle that is designed 30 primarily for agricultural purposes and that is used exclusively in the 31 conduct of agricultural operations, including an implement or vehicle 32 whether self-propelled or otherwise that meets both of the following 33 conditions:

34 (a) Is used solely for agricultural purposes including the 35 preparation or harvesting of cotton, alfalfa, grains and other farm crops.

(b) Is only incidentally operated or moved on a highway whether as
a trailer or self-propelled unit. For the purposes of this subdivision,
"incidentally operated or moved on a highway" means travel between a farm
and another part of the same farm, from one farm to another farm or
between a farm and a place of repair, supply or storage.

41 33. "Limousine" means a motor vehicle providing prearranged ground 42 transportation service for an individual passenger, or a group of 43 passengers, that is arranged in advance or is operated on a regular route 44 or between specified points and includes ground transportation under a 45 contract or agreement for services that includes a fixed rate or time and 1 is provided in a motor vehicle with a seating capacity not exceeding 2 fifteen passengers including the driver.

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34. "Livery vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:

4 (a) Has a seating capacity not exceeding fifteen passengers 5 including the driver.

6 (b) Provides passenger services for a fare determined by a flat 7 rate or flat hourly rate between geographic zones or within a geographic 8 area.

9

(c) Is available for hire on an exclusive or shared ride basis.

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(d) May do any of the following:

 (i) Operate on a regular route or between specified places.
 (ii) Offer prearranged ground transportation service as defined in section 28-141.

(iii) Offer on demand ground transportation service pursuant to a
 contract with a public airport, licensed business entity or organization.

16 35. "Local authority" means any county, municipal or other local 17 board or body exercising jurisdiction over highways under the constitution 18 and laws of this state.

19 36. "Manufacturer" means a person engaged in the business of 20 manufacturing motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers.

21 37. "Moped" means a bicycle, not including an electric bicycle, 22 that is equipped with a helper motor if the vehicle has a maximum piston 23 displacement of fifty cubic centimeters or less, a brake horsepower of one 24 and one-half or less and a maximum speed of twenty-five miles per hour or 25 less on a flat surface with less than a one percent grade.

26 38. "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle that has a seat or saddle 27 for the use of the rider and that is designed to travel on not more than 28 three wheels in contact with the ground but excludes a tractor, an 29 electric bicycle and a moped.

30 39. "Motor driven cycle" means a motorcycle, including every motor 31 scooter, with a motor that produces not more than five horsepower but does 32 not include an electric bicycle.

40. "Motorized quadricycle" means a self-propelled motor vehicle towhich all of the following apply:

35 (a) The vehicle is self-propelled by an emission-free electric
 36 motor and may include pedals operated by the passengers.

37 (b) The vehicle has at least four wheels in contact with the 38 ground.

39 (c) The vehicle seats at least eight passengers, including the 40 driver.

41 (d) The vehicle is operable on a flat surface using solely the 42 electric motor without assistance from the pedals or passengers.

43 (e) The vehicle is a commercial motor vehicle as defined in section44 28-5201.

1 (f) The vehicle is a limousine operating under a vehicle for hire 2 company permit issued pursuant to section 28-9503.

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(g) The vehicle is manufactured by a motor vehicle manufacturer that is licensed pursuant to chapter 10 of this title.

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(h) The vehicle complies with the definition and standards for
low-speed vehicles set forth in federal motor vehicle safety standard 500
and 49 Code of Federal Regulations sections 571.3(b) and 571.500,
respectively.

41. "Motor vehicle":
(a) Means either:

10 11

(i) A self-propelled vehicle.

12 (ii) For the purposes of the laws relating to the imposition of a 13 tax on motor vehicle fuel, a vehicle that is operated on the highways of 14 this state and that is propelled by the use of motor vehicle fuel.

(b) Does not include a personal delivery device, A PERSONAL MOBILE
 CARGO CARRYING DEVICE, a motorized wheelchair, an electric personal
 assistive mobility device, an electric bicycle or a motorized skateboard.
 For the purposes of this subdivision:

19 (i) "Motorized skateboard" means a self-propelled device that has a 20 motor, a deck on which a person may ride and at least two tandem wheels in 21 contact with the ground.

(ii) "Motorized wheelchair" means a self-propelled wheelchair thatis used by a person for mobility.

24 42. "Motor vehicle fuel" includes all products that are commonly or 25 commercially known or sold as gasoline, including casinghead gasoline, natural gasoline and all flammable liquids, and that are composed of a 26 27 mixture of selected hydrocarbons expressly manufactured and blended for 28 the purpose of effectively and efficiently operating internal combustion 29 engines. Motor vehicle fuel does not include inflammable liquids that are 30 specifically manufactured for racing motor vehicles and that are distributed for and used by racing motor vehicles at a racetrack, use fuel 31 32 as defined in section 28-5601, aviation fuel, fuel for jet or turbine powered aircraft or the mixture created at the interface of two different 33 34 substances being transported through a pipeline, commonly known as 35 transmix.

43. "Neighborhood electric vehicle" means a self-propelled
 electrically powered motor vehicle to which all of the following apply:

(a) The vehicle is emission free.

39 (b) The vehicle has at least four wheels in contact with the 40 ground.

41 (c) The vehicle complies with the definition and standards for 42 low-speed vehicles set forth in federal motor vehicle safety standard 500 43 and 49 Code of Federal Regulations sections 571.3(b) and 571.500, 44 respectively. 1 44. "Nonresident" means a person who is not a resident of this state as defined in section 28-2001. 2

45. "Off-road recreational motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle 3 4 that is designed primarily for recreational nonhighway all-terrain travel 5 and that is not operated on a public highway. Off-road recreational motor 6 vehicle does not mean a motor vehicle used for construction, building 7 trade, mining or agricultural purposes.

8 46. "Operator" means a person who drives a motor vehicle on a 9 highway, who is in actual physical control of a motor vehicle on a highway 10 or who is exercising control over or steering a vehicle being towed by a 11 motor vehicle.

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47. "Owner" means:

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(a) A person who holds the legal title of a vehicle.

14 (b) If a vehicle is the subject of an agreement for the conditional 15 sale or lease with the right of purchase on performance of the conditions stated in the agreement and with an immediate right of possession vested 16 17 in the conditional vendee or lessee, the conditional vendee or lessee.

18 (c) If a mortgagor of a vehicle is entitled to possession of the 19 vehicle, the mortgagor.

20 48. "Pedestrian" means any person afoot. A person who uses an 21 electric personal assistive mobility device or a manual or motorized 22 wheelchair is considered a pedestrian unless the manual wheelchair 23 qualifies as a bicycle. For the purposes of this paragraph, "motorized 24 wheelchair" means a self-propelled wheelchair that is used by a person for 25 mobility.

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"Personal delivery device": 49.

27

(a) Means an electronically powered device that:

28 (a) (i) Is operated primarily on sidewalks and within crosswalks 29 and that is designed to transport property.

30 (b) (ii) Weighs less than two hundred pounds, excluding cargo, 31 unless otherwise authorized by a local authority pursuant to section 32 28-627.

(iii) Operates at a maximum speed of seven miles per hour, 33 34 unless otherwise authorized by a local authority pursuant to section 35 28-627.

36 (d) (iv) Is equipped with technology to allow for the operation of 37 the device with or without the active control or monitoring of a natural 38 person.

39 (v) Is equipped with a braking system that when active or 40 engaged enables the personal delivery device to come to a controlled stop. (b) DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICE. 41

50. "PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICE" MEANS AN ELECTRONICALLY 42 43 **POWERED DEVICE THAT:** 

(a) IS OPERATED PRIMARILY ON SIDEWALKS AND WITHIN CROSSWALKS AND 44 45 THAT IS DESIGNED TO TRANSPORT PROPERTY.

- (b) WEIGHS LESS THAN EIGHTY POUNDS, EXCLUDING CARGO.
- 2

(c) OPERATES AT A MAXIMUM SPEED OF TWELVE MILES PER HOUR.

3 (d) IS EQUIPPED WITH TECHNOLOGY TO TRANSPORT PERSONAL PROPERTY WITH 4 THE ACTIVE MONITORING OF A PROPERTY OWNER AND THAT IS PRIMARILY DESIGNED TO REMAIN WITHIN TWENTY-FIVE FEET OF THE PROPERTY OWNER. 5

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(e) IS EQUIPPED WITH A BRAKING SYSTEM THAT WHEN ACTIVE OR ENGAGED 7 ENABLES THE PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICE TO COME TO A CONTROLLED 8 STOP.

9 50. 51. "Power sweeper" means an implement, with or without motive 10 power, that is only incidentally operated or moved on a street or highway and that is designed for the removal of debris, dirt, gravel, litter or 11 12 sand whether by broom, vacuum or regenerative air system from asphaltic concrete or cement concrete surfaces, including parking lots, highways, 13 14 streets and warehouses, and a vehicle on which the implement is 15 permanently mounted.

16 51. 52. "Public transit" means the transportation of passengers on 17 scheduled routes by means of a conveyance on an individual passenger 18 fare-paying basis excluding transportation by a sightseeing bus, school 19 bus or taxi or a vehicle not operated on a scheduled route basis.

20 52. 53. "Reconstructed vehicle" means a vehicle that has been 21 assembled or constructed largely by means of essential parts, new or used, 22 derived from vehicles or makes of vehicles of various names, models and 23 types or that, if originally otherwise constructed, has been materially 24 altered by the removal of essential parts or by the addition or 25 substitution of essential parts, new or used, derived from other vehicles 26 or makes of vehicles. For the purposes of this paragraph, "essential parts" means integral and body parts, the removal, alteration or 27 28 substitution of which will tend to conceal the identity or substantially 29 alter the appearance of the vehicle.

30 53. 54. "Residence district" means the territory contiguous to and 31 including a highway not comprising a business district if the property on 32 the highway for a distance of three hundred feet or more is in the main 33 improved with residences or residences and buildings in use for business.

34 54. 55. "Right-of-way" when used within the context of the 35 regulation of the movement of traffic on a highway means the privilege of 36 the immediate use of the highway. Right-of-way when used within the 37 context of the real property on which transportation facilities and 38 appurtenances to the facilities are constructed or maintained means the 39 lands or interest in lands within the right-of-way boundaries.

40 55. 56. "School bus" means a motor vehicle that is designed for carrying more than ten passengers and that is either: 41

42 (a) Owned by any public or governmental agency or other institution 43 and operated for the transportation of children to or from home or school 44 on a regularly scheduled basis.

1 (b) Privately owned and operated for compensation for the transportation of children to or from home or school on a regularly 2 3 scheduled basis.

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56. 57. "Semitrailer" means a vehicle that is with or without motive power, other than a pole trailer or single-axle tow dolly, that is 5 6 designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor 7 vehicle and that is constructed so that some part of its weight and that 8 of its load rests on or is carried by another vehicle. For the purposes 9 of this paragraph, "pole trailer" has the same meaning prescribed in 10 section 28-601.

11 57. 58. "Single-axle tow dolly" means a nonvehicle device that is 12 drawn by a motor vehicle, that is designed and used exclusively to transport another motor vehicle and on which the front or rear wheels of 13 14 the drawn motor vehicle are mounted on the tow dolly while the other wheels of the drawn motor vehicle remain in contact with the ground. 15

16 58. 59. "State" means a state of the United States and the 17 District of Columbia.

18 59. 60. "State highway" means a state route or portion of a state 19 route that is accepted and designated by the board as a state highway and 20 that is maintained by the state.

21 60. 61. "State route" means a right-of-way whether actually used 22 as a highway or not that is designated by the board as a location for the 23 construction of a state highway.

61. 62. "Street" or "highway" means the entire width between the 24 25 boundary lines of every way if a part of the way is open to the use of the 26 public for purposes of vehicular travel.

62. 63. "Taxi" means a motor vehicle that has a seating capacity 27 28 not exceeding fifteen passengers, including the driver, that provides 29 passenger services and that:

30 (a) Does not primarily operate on a regular route or between 31 specified places.

(b) Offers local transportation for a fare determined on the basis 32 33 of the distance traveled or prearranged ground transportation service as 34 defined in section 28-141 for a predetermined fare.

35 63. 64. "Title transfer form" means a paper or an electronic form 36 that is prescribed by the department for the purpose of transferring a 37 certificate of title from one owner to another owner.

38 65. "Traffic survival school" means a school that offers 39 educational sessions to drivers who are required to attend and 40 successfully complete educational sessions pursuant to this title that are designed to improve the safety and habits of drivers and that are approved 41 42 by the department.

65. 66. "Trailer" means a vehicle that is with or without motive 43 power, other than a pole trailer or single-axle tow dolly, that is 44 45 designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor

vehicle and that is constructed so that no part of its weight rests on the towing vehicle. A semitrailer equipped with an auxiliary front axle commonly known as a dolly is deemed to be a trailer. For the purposes of this paragraph, "pole trailer" has the same meaning prescribed in section 28-601.

6 <del>66.</del> 67. "Transportation network company" has the same meaning 7 prescribed in section 28-9551.

8 67. 68. "Transportation network company vehicle" has the same 9 meaning prescribed in section 28-9551.

10 <del>68.</del> 69. "Transportation network service" has the same meaning 11 prescribed in section 28-9551.

12 <del>69.</del> 70. "Truck" means a motor vehicle designed or used primarily 13 for the carrying of property other than the effects of the driver or 14 passengers and includes a motor vehicle to which has been added a box, a 15 platform or other equipment for such carrying.

16 70. 71. "Truck tractor" means a motor vehicle that is designed and 17 used primarily for drawing other vehicles and that is not constructed to 18 carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and load 19 drawn.

20

71. 72. "Vehicle":

(a) Means a device in, on or by which a person or property is or
 may be transported or drawn on a public highway.

23 (b) Does not include:

24 25 (i) Electric bicycles and devices moved by human power.

(ii) Devices used exclusively on stationary rails or tracks.

26 (iii) Personal delivery devices.

27 28 (iv) PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICES. 72. 73. "Vehicle transporter" means either:

29 (a) A truck tractor capable of carrying a load and drawing a 30 semitrailer.

31 (b) A truck tractor with a stinger-steered fifth wheel capable of 32 carrying a load and drawing a semitrailer or a truck tractor with a dolly 33 mounted fifth wheel that is securely fastened to the truck tractor at two 34 or more points and that is capable of carrying a load and drawing a 35 semitrailer.

"Electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is equipped 39 with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of less than seven 40 hundred fifty watts and that meets the requirements of one of the 41 following classes: 42 (a) "Class 1 electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is equipped with an electric motor that provides assistance only when the 43 rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle 44 45 or tricycle reaches the speed of twenty miles per hour.

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(b) "Class 2 electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is equipped with an electric motor that may be used exclusively to propel the 2 bicycle or tricycle and that is not capable of providing assistance when the bicycle or tricycle reaches the speed of twenty miles per hour. 4

5 (c) "Class 3 electric bicycle" means a bicycle or tricycle that is 6 equipped with an electric motor that provides assistance only when the 7 rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle 8 or tricycle reaches the speed of twenty-eight miles per hour.

9 "Electric personal assistive mobility device" 26. means а 10 self-balancing device with one wheel or two nontandem wheels and an electric propulsion system that limits the maximum speed of the device to 11 12 fifteen miles per hour or less and that is designed to transport only one 13 person.

14

"Evidence" includes both of the following: 27.

15 a wireless communication (a) A display on device of а 16 department-generated driver license, nonoperating identification license, 17 vehicle registration card or other official record of the department that 18 presented to a law enforcement officer or in a court or is an 19 administrative proceeding.

20 (b) An electronic or digital license plate authorized pursuant to 21 section 28-364.

22 28. "Farm" lands primarily used for agriculture means any 23 production.

24 29. "Farm tractor" means a motor vehicle designed and used 25 primarily as a farm implement for drawing implements of husbandry.

30. "Foreign vehicle" means a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer 26 27 that is brought into this state other than in the ordinary course of 28 business by or through a manufacturer or dealer and that has not been 29 registered in this state.

30 31. "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that has not less than three 31 wheels in contact with the ground, that has an unladen weight of less than 32 one thousand eight hundred pounds, that is designed to be and is operated at not more than twenty-five miles per hour and that is designed to carry 33 34 not more than four persons including the driver.

32. "Hazardous material" means a material, and its mixtures or 35 36 solutions, that the United States department of transportation determines 37 under 49 Code of Federal Regulations is, or any quantity of a material 38 listed as a select agent or toxin under 42 Code of Federal Regulations 39 part 73 that is, capable of posing an unreasonable risk to health, safety 40 and property if transported in commerce and that is required to be 41 placarded or marked as required by the department's safety rules 42 prescribed pursuant to chapter 14 of this title.

33. "Implement of husbandry" means a vehicle that is designed 43 primarily for agricultural purposes and that is used exclusively in the 44 45 conduct of agricultural operations, including an implement or vehicle

whether self-propelled or otherwise that meets both of the following conditions:

3 (a) Is used solely for agricultural purposes including the 4 preparation or harvesting of cotton, alfalfa, grains and other farm crops.

5 (b) Is only incidentally operated or moved on a highway whether as 6 a trailer or self-propelled unit. For the purposes of this subdivision, 7 "incidentally operated or moved on a highway" means travel between a farm 8 and another part of the same farm, from one farm to another farm or 9 between a farm and a place of repair, supply or storage.

10 34. "Limousine" means a motor vehicle providing prearranged ground 11 transportation service for an individual passenger, or a group of 12 passengers, that is arranged in advance or is operated on a regular route 13 or between specified points and includes ground transportation under a 14 contract or agreement for services that includes a fixed rate or time and 15 is provided in a motor vehicle with a seating capacity not exceeding 16 fifteen passengers including the driver.

17

35. "Livery vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:

18 (a) Has a seating capacity not exceeding fifteen passengers19 including the driver.

20 (b) Provides passenger services for a fare determined by a flat 21 rate or flat hourly rate between geographic zones or within a geographic 22 area.

23

(c) Is available for hire on an exclusive or shared ride basis.

24 25 (d) May do any of the following:

(i) Operate on a regular route or between specified places.

26 (ii) Offer prearranged ground transportation service as defined in 27 section 28-141.

(iii) Offer on demand ground transportation service pursuant to a
 contract with a public airport, licensed business entity or organization.

30 36. "Local authority" means any county, municipal or other local 31 board or body exercising jurisdiction over highways under the constitution 32 and laws of this state.

37. "Manufacturer" means a person engaged in the business of
 manufacturing motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers.

35 38. "Moped" means a bicycle, not including an electric bicycle, 36 that is equipped with a helper motor if the vehicle has a maximum piston 37 displacement of fifty cubic centimeters or less, a brake horsepower of one 38 and one-half or less and a maximum speed of twenty-five miles per hour or 39 less on a flat surface with less than a one percent grade.

40 39. "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle that has a seat or saddle 41 for the use of the rider and that is designed to travel on not more than 42 three wheels in contact with the ground but excludes a tractor, an 43 electric bicycle and a moped. 1 40. "Motor driven cycle" means a motorcycle, including every motor 2 scooter, with a motor that produces not more than five horsepower but does 3 not include an electric bicycle.

5

4 41. "Motorized quadricycle" means a self-propelled motor vehicle to which all of the following apply: 6

7

(a) The vehicle is self-propelled by an emission-free electric motor and may include pedals operated by the passengers.

8 (b) The vehicle has at least four wheels in contact with the 9 ground.

10 (c) The vehicle seats at least eight passengers, including the 11 driver.

12 (d) The vehicle is operable on a flat surface using solely the electric motor without assistance from the pedals or passengers. 13

14 (e) The vehicle is a commercial motor vehicle as defined in section 15 28-5201.

16 (f) The vehicle is a limousine operating under a vehicle for hire 17 company permit issued pursuant to section 28-9503.

18 (g) The vehicle is manufactured by a motor vehicle manufacturer 19 that is licensed pursuant to chapter 10 of this title.

20 (h) The vehicle complies with the definition and standards for 21 low-speed vehicles set forth in federal motor vehicle safety standard 500 22 and 49 Code of Federal Regulations sections 571.3(b) and 571.500, 23 respectively.

42. "Motor vehicle":

25 (a) Means either:

(i) A self-propelled vehicle.

27 (ii) For the purposes of the laws relating to the imposition of a tax on motor vehicle fuel, a vehicle that is operated on the highways of 28 29 this state and that is propelled by the use of motor vehicle fuel.

30 (b) Does not include a scrap vehicle, a personal delivery device, A 31 PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICE, a motorized wheelchair, an electric 32 personal assistive mobility device, an electric bicycle or a motorized 33 skateboard. For the purposes of this subdivision:

34 (i) "Motorized skateboard" means a self-propelled device that has a 35 motor, a deck on which a person may ride and at least two tandem wheels in 36 contact with the ground.

37 (ii) "Motorized wheelchair" means a self-propelled wheelchair that 38 is used by a person for mobility.

39 43. "Motor vehicle fuel" includes all products that are commonly or 40 commercially known or sold as gasoline, including casinghead gasoline, natural gasoline and all flammable liquids, and that are composed of a 41 mixture of selected hydrocarbons expressly manufactured and blended for 42 the purpose of effectively and efficiently operating internal combustion 43 44 engines. Motor vehicle fuel does not include inflammable liquids that are 45 specifically manufactured for racing motor vehicles and that are

1 distributed for and used by racing motor vehicles at a racetrack, use fuel as defined in section 28-5601, aviation fuel, fuel for jet or turbine 2 3 powered aircraft or the mixture created at the interface of two different 4 substances being transported through a pipeline, commonly known as 5 transmix.

6 44. "Neighborhood electric vehicle" means а self-propelled electrically powered motor vehicle to which all of the following apply: 7

8

(a) The vehicle is emission free.

9 (b) The vehicle has at least four wheels in contact with the ground. 10

(c) The vehicle complies with the definition and standards for 11 12 low-speed vehicles set forth in federal motor vehicle safety standard 500 and 49 Code of Federal Regulations sections 571.3(b) and 571.500, 13 14 respectively.

45. "Nonresident" means a person who is not a resident of this 15 16 state as defined in section 28-2001.

17 46. "Off-road recreational motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle 18 that is designed primarily for recreational nonhighway all-terrain travel and that is not operated on a public highway. Off-road recreational motor 19 20 vehicle does not mean a motor vehicle used for construction, building 21 trade, mining or agricultural purposes.

22 47. "Operator" means a person who drives a motor vehicle on a 23 highway, who is in actual physical control of a motor vehicle on a highway 24 or who is exercising control over or steering a vehicle being towed by a 25 motor vehicle.

26

48. "Owner" means:

27

(a) A person who holds the legal title of a vehicle.

28 (b) If a vehicle is the subject of an agreement for the conditional 29 sale or lease with the right of purchase on performance of the conditions 30 stated in the agreement and with an immediate right of possession vested in the conditional vendee or lessee, the conditional vendee or lessee. 31

32 (c) If a mortgagor of a vehicle is entitled to possession of the 33 vehicle, the mortgagor.

34 49. "Pedestrian" means any person afoot. A person who uses an 35 electric personal assistive mobility device or a manual or motorized 36 wheelchair is considered a pedestrian unless the manual wheelchair 37 qualifies as a bicycle. For the purposes of this paragraph, "motorized 38 wheelchair" means a self-propelled wheelchair that is used by a person for 39 mobility.

40 41 50. "Personal delivery device":

(a) Means an electronically powered device that:

42 (i) Is operated primarily on sidewalks and within crosswalks 43 and that is designed to transport property.

1 (ii) Weighs less than two hundred pounds, excluding cargo, unless otherwise authorized by a local authority pursuant to section 2 3 28-627. 4 (iii) Operates at a maximum speed of seven miles per hour, 5 unless otherwise authorized by a local authority pursuant to section 6 28-627. 7 (d) (iv) Is equipped with technology to allow for the operation of 8 the device with or without the active control or monitoring of a natural 9 person. 10 (e) (v) Is equipped with a braking system that when active or 11 engaged enables the personal delivery device to come to a controlled stop. 12 (b) DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICE. "PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICE" MEANS AN ELECTRONICALLY 13 51. 14 **POWERED DEVICE THAT:** (a) IS OPERATED PRIMARILY ON SIDEWALKS AND WITHIN CROSSWALKS AND 15 16 THAT IS DESIGNED TO TRANSPORT PROPERTY. 17 (b) WEIGHS LESS THAN EIGHTY POUNDS, EXCLUDING CARGO. 18 (c) OPERATES AT A MAXIMUM SPEED OF TWELVE MILES PER HOUR. (d) IS EQUIPPED WITH TECHNOLOGY TO TRANSPORT PERSONAL PROPERTY WITH 19 20 THE ACTIVE MONITORING OF A PROPERTY OWNER AND THAT IS PRIMARILY DESIGNED TO REMAIN WITHIN TWENTY-FIVE FEET OF THE PROPERTY OWNER. 21 22 (e) IS EQUIPPED WITH A BRAKING SYSTEM THAT WHEN ACTIVE OR ENGAGED 23 ENABLES THE PERSONAL MOBILE CARGO CARRYING DEVICE TO COME TO A CONTROLLED 24 STOP. 25 51. 52. "Power sweeper" means an implement, with or without motive 26 power, that is only incidentally operated or moved on a street or highway 27 and that is designed for the removal of debris, dirt, gravel, litter or 28 sand whether by broom, vacuum or regenerative air system from asphaltic 29 concrete or cement concrete surfaces, including parking lots, highways, 30 streets and warehouses, and a vehicle on which the implement is 31 permanently mounted. 52. 53. "Public transit" means the transportation of passengers on 32 33 scheduled routes by means of a conveyance on an individual passenger 34 fare-paying basis excluding transportation by a sightseeing bus, school 35 bus or taxi or a vehicle not operated on a scheduled route basis. 36 53. 54. "Reconstructed vehicle" means a vehicle that has been 37 assembled or constructed largely by means of essential parts, new or used, 38 derived from vehicles or makes of vehicles of various names, models and 39 types or that, if originally otherwise constructed, has been materially 40 altered by the removal of essential parts or by the addition or substitution of essential parts, new or used, derived from other vehicles 41 or makes of vehicles. For the purposes of this paragraph, "essential 42 parts" means integral and body parts, the removal, alteration or 43 substitution of which will tend to conceal the identity or substantially 44 45 alter the appearance of the vehicle.

1 54. 55. "Residence district" means the territory contiguous to and 2 including a highway not comprising a business district if the property on 3 the highway for a distance of three hundred feet or more is in the main 4 improved with residences or residences and buildings in use for business.

5 55. 56. "Right-of-way" when used within the context of the 6 regulation of the movement of traffic on a highway means the privilege of 7 the immediate use of the highway. Right-of-way when used within the 8 context of the real property on which transportation facilities and 9 appurtenances to the facilities are constructed or maintained means the 10 lands or interest in lands within the right-of-way boundaries.

11 56. 57. "School bus" means a motor vehicle that is designed for 12 carrying more than ten passengers and that is either:

(a) Owned by any public or governmental agency or other institution
 and operated for the transportation of children to or from home or school
 on a regularly scheduled basis.

16 (b) Privately owned and operated for compensation for the 17 transportation of children to or from home or school on a regularly 18 scheduled basis.

19 57. 58. "Scrap metal dealer" has the same meaning prescribed in 20 section 44-1641.

21 58. 59. "Scrap vehicle" has the same meaning prescribed in section 22 44-1641.

59. 60. "Semitrailer" means a vehicle that is with or without motive power, other than a pole trailer or single-axle tow dolly, that is designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor vehicle and that is constructed so that some part of its weight and that of its load rests on or is carried by another vehicle. For the purposes of this paragraph, "pole trailer" has the same meaning prescribed in section 28-601.

30 60. 61. "Single-axle tow dolly" means a nonvehicle device that is 31 drawn by a motor vehicle, that is designed and used exclusively to 32 transport another motor vehicle and on which the front or rear wheels of 33 the drawn motor vehicle are mounted on the tow dolly while the other 34 wheels of the drawn motor vehicle remain in contact with the ground.

35 <del>61.</del> 62. "State" means a state of the United States and the 36 District of Columbia.

37 62. 63. "State highway" means a state route or portion of a state 38 route that is accepted and designated by the board as a state highway and 39 that is maintained by the state.

40 <del>63.</del> 64. "State route" means a right-of-way whether actually used 41 as a highway or not that is designated by the board as a location for the 42 construction of a state highway.

43 64. 65. "Street" or "highway" means the entire width between the 44 boundary lines of every way if a part of the way is open to the use of the 45 public for purposes of vehicular travel. 1 65. 66. "Taxi" means a motor vehicle that has a seating capacity 2 not exceeding fifteen passengers, including the driver, that provides 3 passenger services and that:

6 (b) Offers local transportation for a fare determined on the basis 7 of the distance traveled or prearranged ground transportation service as 8 defined in section 28-141 for a predetermined fare.

9 <del>66.</del> 67. "Title transfer form" means a paper or an electronic form 10 that is prescribed by the department for the purpose of transferring a 11 certificate of title from one owner to another owner.

"Traffic survival school" means a school that offers 13 educational sessions to drivers who are required to attend and 14 successfully complete educational sessions pursuant to this title that are 15 designed to improve the safety and habits of drivers and that are approved 16 by the department.

17 68. 69. "Trailer" means a vehicle that is with or without motive 18 power, other than a pole trailer or single-axle tow dolly, that is 19 designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor 20 vehicle and that is constructed so that no part of its weight rests on the 21 A semitrailer equipped with an auxiliary front axle towing vehicle. 22 commonly known as a dolly is deemed to be a trailer. For the purposes of 23 this paragraph, "pole trailer" has the same meaning prescribed in section 24 28-601.

27 70. 71. "Transportation network company vehicle" has the same

31 72. 73. "Truck" means a motor vehicle designed or used primarily 32 for the carrying of property other than the effects of the driver or 33 passengers and includes a motor vehicle to which has been added a box, a 34 platform or other equipment for such carrying.

35 <del>73.</del> 74. "Truck tractor" means a motor vehicle that is designed and 36 used primarily for drawing other vehicles and that is not constructed to 37 carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and load 38 drawn.

39 <del>74.</del> 75. "Vehicle":

40 (a) Means a device in, on or by which a person or property is or 41 may be transported or drawn on a public highway.

- 43 (i) Electric bicycles and devices moved by human power.

- 45 (iii) Personal delivery devices.
