AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 48-2053, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SANITARY DISTRICTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 48-2053, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 48-2053. Option of sanitary district to reject bids; sanitary
5 district as contractor; limitation of assessment

6 The board ~~may~~, within ~~ten~~ THIRTY days after the time fixed for
7 opening bids, MAY by resolution adopted by a vote of two-thirds of its
8 members, order that the proposed contract not be entered into and that the
9 sanitary district itself perform the work according to the plans and
10 specifications as adopted for the work. If it is so ordered, the district
11 ~~shall be~~ IS considered the contractor. The district ~~shall not be~~
12 ~~permitted to~~ MAY NOT assess an amount in excess of the amount proposed by
13 the lowest responsible bidder or, if no bids have been received, in excess
14 of the amount of the estimate.
