AMENDING SECTION 41-115, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ALCOHOL,
TOBACCO AND DRUG EDUCATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-115, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 41-115. Alcohol, tobacco and drug education; appropriation;

6 A. The governor's office of youth, faith and family or the
7 department of health services may partner with state and local education
8 agencies and facility-based nonprofit youth development organizations to
9 annually teach children in grades five through twelve about the health
10 dangers of federally defined illegal substances, tobacco, **ELECTRONIC**
11 **SMOKING DEVICES**, alcohol, marijuana, opioids and nonprescription
12 pharmaceuticals.

13 B. THE SUM OF \$1,000,000 IS APPROPRIATED FROM THE STATE GENERAL
14 FUND IN EACH FISCAL YEAR TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE
15 PURPOSES PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

16 ~~B.~~ C. For the purposes of this section, "facility-based nonprofit
17 youth development organization" means an organization that provides proven
18 and tested recreational, educational and character-building programs for
19 children who are at least six and under nineteen years of age.
