A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROCLAIMING NOVEMBER 1, 2019 AS ACCESS TO POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRAINING DAY.

1 Whereas, having an educated and skilled workforce is the foundation
2 for success in a global economy; and

3 Whereas, citizens across Arizona agree that expanding access to
4 quality postsecondary education and training opportunities should be an
5 issue of great importance to our state's leaders; and

6 Whereas, this state recognizes the critical role that affordability
7 plays in the ability of Arizonans to enroll in quality postsecondary
8 education and training programs; and

9 Whereas, Arizona has a multitude of public and private postsecondary
10 education and training programs; and

11 Whereas, the vital cause of improving Arizona's economy is one that
12 transcends ideology and political party affiliation; and

13 Whereas, research in this state and across the nation demonstrates
14 conclusively that increasing postsecondary education and training leads to
15 increased individual earnings, higher productivity and positive economic
16 development.

17 Therefore

18 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
19 the Senate concurring:

20 That the Members of the Legislature proclaim November 1, 2019 as
21 Access to Postsecondary Education and Training Day in Arizona to increase
22 awareness of the benefits of postsecondary education and training and how
23 to access postsecondary education and training opportunities.
