AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 1-272; RELATING TO SOVEREIGN AUTHORITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 1, chapter 2, article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 1-272, to read:

4 1-272. Sovereign authority: right of the people to keep and
5 bear arms

6 PURSUANT TO THE SOVEREIGN AUTHORITY OF THIS STATE AND ARTICLE II,
7 SECTION 3, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA:

8 1. AN ACT, LAW, TREATY, ORDER, RULE OR REGULATION OF THE UNITED
9 STATES GOVERNMENT THAT VIOLATES AMENDMENT II OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
10 UNITED STATES IS NULL, VOID AND UNENFORCEABLE IN THIS STATE.

11 2. THIS STATE AND ALL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THIS STATE ARE
12 PROHIBITED FROM USING ANY PERSONNEL OR FINANCIAL RESOURCES TO ENFORCE,
13 ADMINISTER OR COOPERATE WITH ANY ACT, LAW, TREATY, ORDER, RULE OR
14 REGULATION OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT THAT VIOLATES AMENDMENT II OF
15 THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES.

16 Sec. 2. Short title

17 This act may be cited as the "2nd Amendment Firearm Freedom Act".
