AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 17, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 17-308.01; RELATING TO THE TAKING AND HANDLING OF WILDLIFE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 17, chapter 3, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 17-308.01, to read:

4 17-308.01. Unlawful activities near water holes, stockponds
5 and other man-made watering facilities; notice;
6 civil penalty

7 A. A PERSON MAY NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WITHIN ONE HUNDRED
8 YARDS OF A NATURAL WATER HOLE CONTAINING WATER OR A STOCKPOND OR OTHER
9 MAN-MADE WATERING FACILITY CONTAINING WATER:

10 1. SET UP A BLIND, LIE IN WAIT OR OTHERWISE CONCEAL ONESELF FOR THE
11 PURPOSE OF TAKING WILDLIFE.

12 2. FIELD DRESS TAKEN WILDLIFE.

13 B. A LANDOWNER OR LESSEE OF PRIVATE LAND MAY POST A NOTICE OR SIGN
14 TO NOTIFY PERSONS OF THE ACTIVITIES PROHIBITED BY THIS SECTION.

15 C. THE COMMISSION MAY IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN \$250
16 AGAINST ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.
