AMENDING SECTION 41-1080.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO STATE
LICENSING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1080.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 41-1080.01. Licensing fees; waiver; definitions

5 A. Except for an individual who applies for a license pursuant to
6 title 36, chapter 4, article 10 or chapter 28.1, an agency shall waive any
7 fee charged for an initial license for ANY OF THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS IF
8 THE INDIVIDUAL IS APPLYING FOR THAT SPECIFIC LICENSE IN THIS STATE FOR THE
9 FIRST TIME:

10 1. Any individual applicant whose family income does not exceed two
11 hundred percent of the federal poverty guidelines ~~if the individual is~~
12 ~~applying for that specific license in this state for the first time.~~

13 2. ANY ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY SERVICE MEMBER AND THE MEMBER'S SPOUSE.

14 3. ANY VETERAN.

15 B. For the purposes of this section, "agency" and "license" have
16 the same meanings prescribed in section 41-1080.
