MAKING CAPITAL OUTLAY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS OF THE
STATE AND FOR STATE INSTITUTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; department of veterans' services;
3 Ganado senior and veterans center building

4 The sum of \$1,444,100 is appropriated from the state general fund in
5 fiscal year 2020-2021 to the department of veterans' services to
6 distribute to the Navajo Nation for costs associated with constructing the
7 Ganado senior and veterans center building.

8 Sec. 2. Appropriation; department of public safety; Blue
9 Gap/Tachee Chapter public substation

10 The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
11 fiscal year 2020-2021 to the department of public safety to distribute to
12 the Navajo Nation for costs associated with the utility connections for
13 the Blue Gap/Tachee Chapter public substation facility.

14 Sec. 3. Appropriation; department of veterans' services;
15 Tselani/Cottonwood Chapter veterans building

16 The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
17 fiscal year 2020-2021 to the department of veterans' services to
18 distribute to the Navajo Nation for costs associated with constructing the
19 Tselani/Cottonwood Chapter veterans building.

20 Sec. 4. Appropriation; Arizona department of agriculture;
21 Nazlini Chapter irrigation development

22 The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
23 fiscal year 2020-2021 to the Arizona department of agriculture to
24 distribute to the Navajo Nation for costs associated with constructing the
25 Nazlini Chapter farming irrigation development project.

26 Sec. 5. Appropriation; department of transportation; State
27 Route 191

28 The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
29 fiscal year 2020-2021 to the department of transportation to distribute to
30 the Navajo Nation for costs associated with constructing a right-of-way
31 access road and improvements to State Route 191 between Many Farms and
32 Round Rock.

33 Sec. 6. Appropriation; department of transportation; Kin Dah
34 Lichii Chapter bridge replacement projects

35 The sum of \$2,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
36 fiscal year 2020-2021 to the department of transportation to distribute to
37 the Navajo Nation for costs associated with the Kin Dah Lichii Chapter
38 bridge replacement projects.
