REPEALING SECTION 28-2007, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING SECTION
41-1752, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO VEHICLE FEES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Repeal
3 Section ~~28-2007~~, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.
4 Sec. 2. Section 41-1752, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

7 A. An Arizona highway patrol fund is established.
8 B. The Arizona highway patrol fund consists of:
9 1. Monies distributed to the fund from the Arizona highway user
10 revenue fund by the legislature subject to section 28-6537.
11 2. Miscellaneous service fees.
12 3. Rewards.
13 4. Awards.
14 5. Insurance recoveries.
15 6. Receipts from the sale or disposal of any property held by the
16 Arizona highway patrol or purchased with Arizona highway patrol monies.
17 7. Monies received from the public safety personnel retirement
18 system pursuant to section 20-224.01.
19 8. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-3513.
20 ~~9. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-2007.~~
21 C. Subject to legislative appropriation, the patrol superintendent
22 shall administer and spend monies in the Arizona highway patrol fund in
23 conformity with the laws governing state financial operations.
24 D. Monies in the Arizona highway patrol fund:
25 1. Do not revert to the state general fund or Arizona highway user
26 revenue fund.
27 2. Are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190 relating to
28 lapsing of appropriations.
29 E. Subject to legislative appropriation, monies in the Arizona
30 highway patrol fund shall be used to administer the provisions of law
31 relating to the highway patrol and the Arizona highway patrol reserve and
32 all matters pertaining to those laws, except that monies received pursuant
33 to subsection B, paragraph 7 of this section shall be used for the
34 department of public safety.
