AMENDING SECTION 12-508, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO LIMITATIONS OF ACTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 12-508, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 12-508. Restarting of limitation period after debt payment;
5 effect of acknowledgment

6 A. WHEN AN ACTION FOR DEBT HAS ACCRUED BUT IS NOT YET BARRED BY
7 LIMITATION AND ANY PAYMENT IS MADE TOWARD THE DEBT, THE LIMITATION PERIOD
8 BEGINS ANEW FROM THE DATE OF THE LAST PAYMENT MADE.

9 B. When an action is barred by limitation ~~no acknowledgment of the~~
10 ~~justness of the claim made subsequent to the time it became due shall be~~
11 ~~admitted in evidence to take the action out of the operation of the law,~~
12 ~~THE RIGHT TO PURSUE THE ACTION IS NOT REVIVED unless the acknowledgment is~~
13 ~~in writing and signed by~~ the party to be charged ~~thereby~~ SIGNS A WRITTEN
14 ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE CLAIM.

15 C. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 12-505, THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL
16 PAYMENTS MADE TOWARD A DEBT ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2012.
