AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 45-604, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE GROUNDWATER CODE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 45-604, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 45-604. Water measuring devices

5 A. Except as provided in subsections B, C and D of this section, a
6 person who withdraws groundwater from a nonexempt well ~~in an active~~
~~management area or an irrigation non-expansion area, a person who~~
~~withdraws water from a non-exempt well in the Santa Cruz active management~~
~~area or a person who withdraws groundwater for transportation to an~~
~~initial active management area pursuant to article 8.1 of this chapter~~
10 shall use a water measuring device approved by the director.

11 B. A person who holds a type 2 non-irrigation grandfathered right
12 or a groundwater withdrawal permit in the amount of ten or fewer acre-feet
13 per year is not required to use a water measuring device to measure
14 withdrawals pursuant to that grandfathered right or groundwater withdrawal
15 permit unless the person holds more than one such right or permit in the
16 aggregate amount of more than ten acre-feet per year and withdraws more
17 than ten acre-feet of groundwater per year pursuant to those rights or
18 permits from one well.

19 C. ~~in an irrigation non-expansion area:~~

20 ~~1.~~ A person who withdraws ten or fewer acre-feet of groundwater per
21 year from a ~~non-exempt~~ NONEXEMPT well for a non-irrigation use is not
22 required to use a water measuring device to measure withdrawals from that
23 well.

24 ~~2.~~ A person who withdraws groundwater from a ~~non-exempt~~ NONEXEMPT
25 well for an irrigation use is not required to use a water measuring device
26 to measure withdrawals from that well if both of the following apply:

27 ~~(a)~~ 1. Groundwater withdrawn from the well for an irrigation use
28 is used only on land that is owned by a person who has the right under
29 section 45-437 to irrigate ten or fewer contiguous acres at the place of
30 the use.

31 ~~(b)~~ 2. Groundwater withdrawn from the well is not used on land
32 that is part of an integrated farming operation.

33 D. In an active management area, a person, other than an irrigation
34 district, who withdraws groundwater from a ~~non-exempt~~ NONEXEMPT well for
35 use pursuant to an irrigation grandfathered right that is appurtenant to
36 ten or fewer irrigation acres is not required to use a water measuring
37 device to measure withdrawals from that well unless groundwater withdrawn
38 from the well is also used pursuant to either a service area right
39 pursuant to article 6 of this chapter or a grandfathered groundwater right
40 other than an irrigation grandfathered right that is appurtenant to
41 irrigation acres that are exempt from irrigation water duties pursuant to
42 section 45-563.02.

43 E. The director shall adopt rules setting forth the requirements
44 and specifications for water measuring devices.
