SENATE BILL 1047

AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 41-3021.12, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3029.12; RELATING TO THE BOARD OF FINGERPRINTING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Section ~~41-3021.12~~, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,
5 is amended by adding section 41-3029.12, to read:

6 ~~41-3029.12.~~ Board of fingerprinting; termination July 1, 2029

7 A. THE BOARD OF FINGERPRINTING TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2029.

8 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 12 AND THIS SECTION ARE REPEALED ON
9 JANUARY 1, 2030.

10 Sec. 3. Purpose

11 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
12 the legislature continues the board of fingerprinting to conduct good
13 cause exception hearings for personnel who require a fingerprint clearance
14 card and central registry exception hearings for personnel who require a
15 central registry background check.

16 Sec. 4. Retroactivity

17 Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply retroactively to from and after
18 July 1, 2021.
