REPEALING SECTION 41-3022.03, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3030.03; RELATING TO THE STATE BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Repeal
3 Section 41-3022.03, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.
4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,
5 is amended by adding section 41-3030.03, to read:
6 41-3030.03. State board of chiropractic examiners;
7 termination July 1, 2030
8 A. THE STATE BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS TERMINATES ON JULY 1,
9 2030.
10 B. TITLE 32, CHAPTER 8 AND THIS SECTION ARE REPEALED ON JANUARY 1,
11 2031.
12 Sec. 3. Purpose
13 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
14 the legislature continues the state board of chiropractic examiners to
15 promote the safe and professional practice of chiropractic.
16 Sec. 4. Retroactivity
17 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
18 2022.
