**CHAPTER 206**  
**HOUSE BILL 2583**

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE DATA COLLECTION STUDY  
COMMITTEE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Driving under the influence data collection study  
3 committee; membership; duties; report; delayed  
4 repeal

5 A. The driving under the influence data collection study committee  
6 is established consisting of the following members:

7 1. The director of the governor's office of highway safety.

8 2. The director of the department of public safety or the  
9 director's designee.

10 3. The superintendent of the department of public safety's crime  
11 laboratory.

12 4. The president of the Arizona association of chiefs of police or  
13 the president's designee.

14 5. The first vice president of the Arizona association of chiefs of  
15 police or the first vice president's designee.

16 6. The president of the Arizona sheriff's association or the  
17 president's designee.

18 7. The executive director of the Arizona prosecuting attorneys'  
19 advisory council or the executive director's designee.

20 8. The chairperson of the Arizona prosecuting attorneys' advisory  
21 council or the chairperson's designee.

22 9. Two driving under the influence awareness advocates, one of whom  
23 is appointed by the president of the senate and one of whom is appointed  
24 by the speaker of the house of representatives.

25 10. The executive director of the Arizona criminal justice  
26 commission or the executive director's designee.

27 11. The administrative director of the Arizona administrative  
28 office of the courts or the administrative director's designee.

29 12. One member of the house of representatives who is appointed by  
30 the speaker of the house of representatives.

31 13. One member of the senate who is appointed by the president of  
32 the senate.

33 B. Committee members are not eligible to receive compensation.

34 C. The committee shall:

35 1. Select a chairperson.

36 2. Meet as often as the chairperson deems necessary.

37 3. Gather information to understand current driving under the  
38 influence related data collection processes among the various law  
39 enforcement agencies, crime labs, prosecutorial offices and courts in this  
40 state.

41 4. Recommend data collection processes and systems and the  
42 necessary funding to centralize driving under the influence related data  
43 reporting and collection to guide the legislature, law enforcement  
44 agencies, crime labs, prosecutorial offices and the courts in this state  
45 when developing policies to better enforce driving under the influence

1 laws, reduce the number and impact of impaired drivers and educate the  
2 public on the consequences of driving while impaired.

3 5. On or before December 16, 2022, submit a report regarding the  
4 committee's activities and recommendations for administrative or  
5 legislative action to the governor, the president of the senate and the  
6 speaker of the house of representatives.

7 D. The legislature shall staff committee meetings.

8 E. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2023.
