REPEALING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 4.2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES;
AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING A NEW
ARTICLE 4.2; RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Repeal
3 Title 36, chapter 6, article 4.2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
4 repealed.
5 Sec. 2. Title 36, chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
6 by adding a new article 4.2, to read:
7 ARTICLE 4.2. PUBLIC HEALTH MANDATES
8 36-681. Vaccinations; enforcement prohibition; violation;
9 classification; definition
10 A. ANY GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY MAY NOT REQUIRE A PERSON UNDER EIGHTEEN
11 YEARS OF AGE TO RECEIVE A VACCINATION FOR COVID-19 OR ANY VARIANT OF
12 COVID-19 WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
13 B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 1
14 MISDEMEANOR.
15 C. THE COUNTY ATTORNEY MAY PROSECUTE ANY VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
16 D. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY" MEANS
17 THIS STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE THAT RECEIVES AND
18 USES STATE TAX REVENUES.
19 Sec. 3. Short title
20 This act may be cited as the "Health Care Freedom Act".
