- 1 Page 2, line 13, after "require" strike remainder of line
- 2 Line 14, strike "instruction to" insert "THAT, WITHIN THREE YEARS AFTER A CERTIFICATE FOR ELEMENTARY EDUCATION OR EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION IS ISSUED, THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER"
- 3 Line 17, after "(a)" insert "SCIENCE OF READING INSTRUCTION, INCLUDING"
- 4 Line 23, strike "2022" insert "2025"; after "SHALL" strike remainder of line

4 A. The state board of education shall review the K-3 reading program
5 established pursuant to section 15-211, Arizona Revised Statutes, and shall
6 consider any changes to statute, policy or administration to improve the
7 reading proficiency of students. The state board shall review all of the
8 following:

9 1. The information required in the plans submitted by school
10 districts and charter schools pursuant to section 15-211, Arizona Revised
11 Statutes, the manner in which the plans are submitted to the department of
12 education and the frequency with which school districts and charter schools
13 submit the plans.

14 2. The collection and use of data to inform instruction and policy.

15 3. The written parental notifications prescribed in section 15-701,
16 Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act, and the feasibility of
17 notifications for parents of students in grades four through twelve.

18 4. Intervention and remedial strategies.

19 B. On or before December 15, 2021, the state board of education
20 shall submit a report based on the review prescribed in subsection A of
21 this section, including recommendations, to the governor, the president of
22 the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives and shall
23 provide a copy of this report to the secretary of state.

24 C. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2021."
