AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 16;
RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding
3 chapter 16, to read:

4 CHAPTER 16

5 VACCINE REQUIREMENTS PROHIBITED

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 36-1801. Business entities; services and products; condition
8 on vaccine prohibited

9 A BUSINESS ENTITY DOING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE MAY NOT REQUIRE A
10 PERSON TO DISCLOSE TO THE BUSINESS ENTITY OR A THIRD-PARTY ONLINE
11 APPLICATION WHETHER THE PERSON HAS OR HAS NOT RECEIVED A COVID-19 VACCINE
12 OR A VACCINE TO ADDRESS ANY VARIANT OF COVID-19 AS A CONDITION FOR
13 RECEIVING ANY SERVICE, PRODUCT OR ADMISSION TO AN EVENT OR VENUE.

14 36-1802. Government benefits and services; condition on
15 vaccine prohibited

16 THIS STATE OR A COUNTY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY OR OFFICIAL IN
17 THIS STATE OR ANY UNIVERSITY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE ARIZONA BOARD
18 OF REGENTS MAY NOT REQUIRE A PERSON TO DISCLOSE TO THIS STATE, A COUNTY OR
19 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY OR OFFICIAL OR UNIVERSITY WHETHER THE PERSON HAS
20 RECEIVED A COVID-19 VACCINE OR A VACCINE TO ADDRESS ANY VARIANT OF
21 COVID-19 AS A CONDITION FOR RECEIVING A GOVERNMENT BENEFIT OR SERVICE,
22 INCLUDING SERVICES PROVIDED BY A UNIVERSITY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE
23 ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS.

24 36-1803. Chapter application; denying health care services;
25 prohibition; definition

26 A. THIS CHAPTER DOES NOT PROHIBIT A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL OR A HEALTH
27 CARE INSTITUTION LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS TITLE, INCLUDING HOSPITALS,
28 NURSING CARE INSTITUTIONS, RESIDENTIAL CARE INSTITUTIONS, INTERMEDIATE
29 CARE FACILITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES, GROUP
30 HOMES OR OTHER MEDICAL FACILITIES, FROM REQUIRING DOCUMENTATION FROM A
31 PATIENT, RESIDENT, EMPLOYEE OR VISITOR OF WHETHER THE PERSON HAS OR HAS
32 NOT RECEIVED THE COVID-19 VACCINE OR A VACCINE TO ADDRESS ANY VARIANT OF
33 COVID-19.

34 B. A HEALTH CARE INSTITUTION MAY NOT DENY A PATIENT OR A RESIDENT
35 HEALTH CARE SERVICES BASED ON THE PERSON'S VACCINATION STATUS.

36 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "HEALTH PROFESSIONAL" HAS THE
37 SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 32-3201.

38 36-1804. Violation; classification

39 A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS CHAPTER IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 3
40 MISDEMEANOR.
