HOUSE BILL 2305

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 4-243.03; RELATING TO LIQUOR.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 4, chapter 2, article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 4-243.03, to read:

4 **4-243.03. Alternating proprietorships**

5 ON APPLICATION BY ONE OR MORE PERSONS, THE DIRECTOR MAY APPROVE
6 APPLICATIONS FOR GROUPING TWO OR MORE SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR PRODUCER, CRAFT
7 DISTILLER OR MICROBREWERY LICENSES AT ONE LOCATION UNDER A PLAN OF
8 ALTERNATING PROPRIETORSHIPS IF A LICENSED PRODUCER, CRAFT DISTILLER OR
9 MICROBREWERY HAS RECEIVED APPROVAL OF THE ALTERNATING PROPRIETORSHIP BY
10 THE UNITED STATES ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO TAX AND TRADE BUREAU AND THE
11 PARTICIPATING PRODUCERS, CRAFT DISTILLERS OR MICROBREWERIES OPERATE UNDER
12 THE REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES THAT ARE ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES
13 ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO TAX AND TRADE BUREAU. EACH PARTICIPATING SPIRITUOUS
14 LIQUOR PRODUCER, CRAFT DISTILLER OR MICROBREWERY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR FILING
15 ALL REPORTS THAT RELATE TO ITS PRODUCTION WITH THE UNITED STATES ALCOHOL
16 AND TOBACCO TAX AND TRADE BUREAU AND THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.
