AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 4-243.03; RELATING TO LIQUOR.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 4, chapter 2, article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 4-243.03, to read:

4 4-243.03. Alternating proprietorships

5 ON APPLICATION BY ONE OR MORE PERSONS, THE DIRECTOR MAY APPROVE  
6 APPLICATIONS FOR GROUPING TWO OR MORE SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR PRODUCER OR  
7 MICROBREWERY LICENSES AT ONE LOCATION UNDER A PLAN OF ALTERNATING  
8 PROPRIETORSHIPS IF A LICENSED PRODUCER OR MICROBREWERY HAS RECEIVED  
9 APPROVAL OF THE ALTERNATING PROPRIETORSHIP BY THE UNITED STATES ALCOHOL  
10 AND TOBACCO TAX AND TRADE BUREAU AND THE PARTICIPATING PRODUCERS OR  
11 MICROBREWERIES OPERATE UNDER THE REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES THAT ARE  
12 ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO TAX AND TRADE BUREAU.  
13 EACH PARTICIPATING SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR PRODUCER OR MICROBREWERY IS  
14 RESPONSIBLE FOR FILING ALL REPORTS THAT RELATE TO ITS PRODUCTION WITH THE  
15 UNITED STATES ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO TAX AND TRADE BUREAU AND THE DEPARTMENT  
16 OF REVENUE.
