# HOUSE BILL 2705

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 15-348; RELATING TO LOCAL GOVERNANCE OF SCHOOLS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 3, article 3, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-348, to read:

4 15-348. Dress code policies; traditional tribal regalia;  
5 objects of cultural significance; graduation  
6 ceremonies; definitions

7 A. A SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD, A CHARTER SCHOOL GOVERNING  
8 BODY OR ANY PUBLIC SCHOOL MAY NOT PROHIBIT A STUDENT WHO IS A MEMBER OF A  
9 FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED INDIAN TRIBE OR WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO BE ENROLLED AS A  
10 MEMBER OF A FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED INDIAN TRIBE FROM WEARING TRADITIONAL  
11 TRIBAL REGALIA OR OBJECTS OF CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE AT A GRADUATION  
12 CEREMONY.

13 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "OBJECTS OF CULTURAL  
14 SIGNIFICANCE" AND "TRADITIONAL TRIBAL REGALIA" INCLUDE AN EAGLE FEATHER OR  
15 EAGLE PLUME.

16 Sec. 2. Emergency

17 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the  
18 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by  
19 law.
