AMENDING SECTION 16-182, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
QUALIFICATION AND REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 16-182, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 16-182. False registration; violation; classification;
5 cancellation of registration

6 A. A person who knowingly causes, procures or allows himself to be
7 registered as an elector of any county, city, town, district or precinct,
8 knowing that he is not entitled to such registration, or a person who
9 knowingly causes or procures another person to be registered as an elector
10 of any county, city, town, district or precinct, knowing that such other
11 person is not entitled to such registration, or an officer who knowingly
12 enters the name of any person not entitled to registration ~~upon~~ ON the
13 register or roll of electors, is guilty of a class 6 felony.

14 B. A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY CAUSES, PROCURES OR ALLOWS HIMSELF TO BE
15 REGISTERED AS AN ELECTOR IN THIS STATE SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING IN
16 AN ELECTION IN THIS STATE AND WITHOUT THE REQUISITE INTENT TO REMAIN AS
17 PRESCRIBED BY SECTION 16-101 IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 6 FELONY.

18 ~~B.~~ C. If on the trial of a person charged with an offense under
19 this section, it appears that the accused is registered as an elector of
20 any county, city, town or precinct, without being qualified for such
21 registration, the court shall order ~~his~~ THE ACCUSED'S registration
22 canceled.
