A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION 6, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO MILITARY PERSONNEL.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article VII, section 6, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to
4 be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:

6 6. Residence of military personnel stationed within
7 state

8 Section 6. No ~~soldier, seaman, or marine, in the army~~
9 ~~or navy~~ **MILITARY PERSONNEL** of the United States shall be
10 deemed a resident of this state in consequence of ~~his~~ being
11 stationed at any military or naval place within this state.

12 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
13 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
14 Constitution of Arizona.
