HB 2548: high intensity laser possession; prohibition Sponsor: Representative Kavanagh, LD 23 House Engrossed

Overview

Establishes laser possession at a riot or unlawful assembly as a class 1 misdemeanor.

<u>History</u>

A *riot* occurs when three or more people acting together recklessly uses or threatens force or violence and disturbs the public peace (A.R.S. § 13-2903). *Unlawful assembly* occurs when three or more people assemble with the intent to engage in a riot, or being present at a riot and refusing to obey an official order to disperse (A.R.S. § 13-2902).

An *affirmative defense* is a defense offered by the accused to excuse a criminal act (<u>A.R.S. § 13-103</u>).

Provisions

- 1. Creates a class 1 misdemeanor for *laser possession at a riot or unlawful assembly*, which occurs when a person knowingly possesses a high intensity laser at the location of a riot or unlawful assembly. (Sec. 1)
- 2. Provides an affirmative defense if a person possesses a high intensity laser in the normal course of one's occupation. (Sec. 1)
- 3. Defines high intensity laser. (Sec. 1)
