AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 15-160.01; RELATING TO STUDENT SAFETY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 1, article 5, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-160.01, to read:

4 15-160.01. Child abuse hotline; required posting

5 EACH SCHOOL THAT IS OPERATED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT AND EACH CHARTER
6 SCHOOL SHALL POST IN A CLEARLY VISIBLE LOCATION IN A PUBLIC AREA OF THE
7 SCHOOL THAT IS READILY ACCESSIBLE TO STUDENTS A SIGN THAT CONTAINS ALL OF
8 THE FOLLOWING:

9 1. IN BOLDFACED TYPE, THE TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE CENTRALIZED
10 INTAKE HOTLINE CONCERNING SUSPECTED ABUSE AND NEGLECT OF CHILDREN THAT IS
11 ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION 8-455.

12 2. INSTRUCTIONS TO CALL 911 FOR EMERGENCIES.

13 3. DIRECTIONS FOR ACCESSING THE WEBSITE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD
14 SAFETY FOR MORE INFORMATION ON REPORTING CHILD ABUSE, CHILD NEGLECT AND
15 THE EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN.
