AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 15-701.02; RELATING TO SCHOOL INSTRUCTION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 7, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-701.02, to read:

4 15-701.02. Health education instruction; mental health
5 instruction

6 IN ADOPTING THE COURSE OF STUDY AND COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS PURSUANT
7 TO SECTIONS 15-701 AND 15-701.01, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL
8 REQUIRE THAT ALL HEALTH EDUCATION INSTRUCTION INCLUDE MENTAL HEALTH
9 INSTRUCTION. MENTAL HEALTH INSTRUCTION MAY BE INCLUDED IN A HEALTH COURSE
10 OR ANOTHER EXISTING COURSE AND SHALL INCORPORATE THE MULTIPLE DIMENSIONS
11 OF HEALTH BY INCLUDING MENTAL HEALTH AND THE RELATIONSHIP OF PHYSICAL AND
12 MENTAL HEALTH TO ENHANCE STUDENT UNDERSTANDING, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL
13 LEARNING, ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIOR THAT PROMOTE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING. IN
14 ADOPTING THE MENTAL HEALTH INSTRUCTION REQUIREMENT, THE STATE BOARD OF
15 EDUCATION SHALL CONSULT WITH THE FOLLOWING:

16 1. MENTAL HEALTH EXPERTS, INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE
17 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

18 2. MENTAL HEALTH ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS THAT ARE BASED IN THIS
19 STATE.

20 3. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.
