Bill Number: **HB 2031**

Udall Floor Amendment

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1. Requires an in-state public university or a community college to disseminate policies regarding disability documentation to the public.
 2. Adds that an in-state public university or a community college must continue the interactive process to establish a reasonable accommodation for an individual pursuant to federal law until the university or community college finds an accommodation that meets the needs of the individual and that does not impose an undue burden on the university or community college.

5 THE INTERACTIVE PROCESS TO ESTABLISH A REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION FOR AN
6 INDIVIDUAL PURSUANT TO SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973
7 (P.L. 93-112; 87 STAT. 355; 29 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION 794) AND THE
8 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990 (P.L. 101-336; 104 STAT. 327) UNTIL
9 THE UNIVERSITY OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE FINDS AN ACCOMMODATION OR
10 ACCOMMODATIONS THAT MEET THE NEEDS OF THE INDIVIDUAL AND DO NOT IMPOSE AN
11 UNDUE BURDEN ON THE UNIVERSITY OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE."
