AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-901.07, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
CONCURRENT COURSEWORK.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-901.07, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 15-901.07. Concurrent coursework; calculation of average
5 daily membership; definition

6 A. A school district or a charter school may include students
7 enrolled in concurrent coursework for the purposes of calculating average
8 daily membership if the school district has received approval from the
9 state board of education or the charter school has received approval from
10 its sponsor to offer concurrent coursework and all of the following apply:

11 1. A student earns at least three semester hours of credit per
12 semester in the community college or university course.

13 2. A STUDENT RECEIVES A GRADE OF C OR HIGHER IN THE COMMUNITY
14 COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY COURSE.

15 ~~2.~~ 3. A student is awarded academic credit by the school district
16 or charter school for the concurrent coursework pursuant to section
17 15-701.01.

18 ~~3.~~ 4. The concurrent coursework is at a higher level than the
19 course taught at the school district or charter school in grades nine
20 through twelve.

21 ~~4.~~ 5. A student who is enrolled in concurrent coursework also
22 attends at least one course offered at the school district or charter
23 school per semester.

24 ~~5.~~ 6. The concurrent coursework is applicable to an established
25 community college academic degree or certificate program that is
26 transferable to a university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board
27 of regents. Concurrent coursework that is applicable to a community
28 college occupational degree or certificate program may be transferable to
29 a university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of regents.

30 ~~6.~~ 7. The school district or charter school pays the community
31 college or university for the tuition cost of the concurrent coursework or
32 reimburses the student for the tuition cost of the concurrent coursework.

33 B. A course at a community college or university of three semester
34 hours of credit or more is considered a subject for the purposes of
35 meeting the definition of full-time student prescribed in section 15-901.
36 A course at a community college or university of three semester hours of
37 credit or more is not required to meet one hundred twenty-three hours a
38 year, or the equivalent, to be considered a subject.

39 C. Instructional hours provided by a community college or
40 university to a student in concurrent coursework shall be included in the
41 calculation of the average daily membership for that student pursuant to
42 section 15-901.

43 D. Average daily membership for classes at a community college or
44 university shall be based on the community college or university credits
45 earned by the student. For each community college or university course

1 for which three credits are earned WITH A GRADE OF A C OR HIGHER,
2 one-eighth of an average daily membership shall be generated. Except as
3 otherwise provided by law, for a full-time high school student who attends
4 concurrent enrollment courses pursuant to this section, the average daily
5 membership may not exceed ~~1.0~~ 1.25.

6 E. For the purposes of this section, "concurrent coursework" means
7 courses at a community college under the jurisdiction of a community
8 college district in this state or at a university under the jurisdiction
9 of the Arizona board of regents in the required or elective subjects that
10 satisfy high school graduation requirements pursuant to section 15-701.01.
