# **SB 1036**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-506, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SCHOOL EMPLOYEES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-506, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 15-506. Flag, Constitution and Bill of Rights display;  
5 recitation of pledge of allegiance; exemption;  
6 civil penalty

7 A. School districts and charter schools shall:

8 1. Acquire United States flags that are manufactured in the United  
9 States and that are at least two feet by three feet and hardware to  
10 appropriately display the United States flags.

11 2. For grades seven through twelve, acquire a legible copy of the  
12 Constitution of the United States and the Bill of Rights that is  
13 manufactured in the United States.

14 3. Display the flags in accordance with title 4 of the United  
15 States Code in each classroom and on or near the outside of the school  
16 building during school hours and at such other times as the school  
17 authorities direct.

18 4. For grades seven through twelve, place a legible copy of the  
19 Constitution of the United States and the Bill of Rights adjacent to each  
20 classroom flag.

21 5. Set aside a specific time each day for ~~those~~ students who wish  
22 to recite the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag.

23 B. Private schools, parochial schools and homeschools are exempt  
24 from this section.

25 C. A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION  
26 IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 FOR EACH VIOLATION.  
27 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL IMPOSE AND COLLECT THE CIVIL PENALTIES UNDER  
28 THIS SUBSECTION.
