AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 9, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 16-567; RELATING TO CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 9, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-567, to read:

4 16-567. Drive-up voting and drop boxes prohibited; exception

5 EXCEPT AS REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 16-581, TITLE 41, CHAPTER
6 9, ARTICLE 5, THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990 (P.L. 101-336)
7 OR OTHER FEDERAL LAW, THE COUNTY RECORDER OR OFFICER IN CHARGE OF
8 ELECTIONS MAY NOT:

9 1. PROVIDE FOR OR ALLOW A VOTER TO RECEIVE A BALLOT AND VOTE FROM A
10 VEHICLE OR OTHER CONVEYANCE.

11 2. USE A BALLOT DROP BOX EXCEPT INSIDE A POLLING PLACE OR VOTING
12 CENTER OR THE COUNTY RECORDER'S OR ELECTION DEPARTMENT'S OFFICES OR
13 FACILITIES. APPROPRIATELY TRAINED ELECTION WORKERS SHALL MONITOR BALLOT
14 DROP BOXES.
