AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 12-821, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ACTIONS AGAINST PUBLIC ENTITIES OR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 12-821, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 12-821. General limitation; gift clause violation; public
5 entity or public employee

6 A. EXCEPT AS REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION, all actions
7 against any public entity or public employee shall be brought within one
8 year after the cause of action accrues and not afterward.

9 B. AN ACTION AGAINST A PUBLIC ENTITY OR PUBLIC EMPLOYEE THAT
10 ALLEGES A VIOLATION OF ARTICLE IX, SECTION 7, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA,
11 SHALL BE BROUGHT WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE CAUSE OF ACTION ACCRUES AND
12 NOT AFTERWARD.
