AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 16-407.04; RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-407.04, to read:

4 16-407.04. Election systems and activities; unique password  
5 required; violation; classification

6 A. FOR ANY ELECTION SYSTEM OR ACTIVITY THAT REQUIRES AN EMPLOYEE,  
7 CONTRACTOR OR VOLUNTEER TO LOG IN TO THE SYSTEM, EACH EMPLOYEE, CONTRACTOR  
8 OR VOLUNTEER SHALL HAVE A UNIQUE PASSWORD THAT MAY NOT BE DISCLOSED TO ANY  
9 OTHER PERSON. EACH EMPLOYEE, CONTRACTOR OR VOLUNTEER SHALL ESTABLISH A  
10 NEW UNIQUE PASSWORD EVERY TWO WEEKS.

11 B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 2  
12 MISDEMEANOR.
