A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE IX, SECTION 10, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO TAXATION.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article IX, section 10, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to
4 be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:

6 10. Aid of church, private or sectarian school, or
7 public service corporation; exception

8 Section 10. A. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION B OF
9 THIS SECTION, no tax shall be laid or appropriation of public
10 money made in aid of any church, ~~or~~ ANY private or sectarian
11 school, or any public service corporation.

12 B. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE
13 LEGISLATURE BY LAW MAY ALLOW PROPERTY OWNERS IN THIS STATE TO
14 ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPERTY TAXES LEVIED
15 AND ASSESSED AGAINST THE PROPERTY OWNER'S PRIMARY RESIDENCE TO
16 A PRIVATE SCHOOL IN THIS STATE.

17 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
18 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
19 Constitution of Arizona.
