FACT SHEET FOR S.B. 1346

state employees; vaccination inquiries prohibited

Purpose

Prohibits the state or any state agency or contractor for the state from sending its employees door-to-door to inquire about a person's vaccination status.

Background

On April 19, 2021, the Governor issued an Executive Order prohibiting a state agency, county, city, town or other political subdivision from adopting any order, policy, regulation, ordinance or other measure that requires an individual to provide documentation regarding the individual's COVID-19 vaccination status as a condition of: 1) entering any building, business, facility, location, park or other space; or 2) receiving any service, permit, license or other work authorization requirement ([Executive Order 2021-09](#)).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the state General Fund associated with this legislation.

Provisions

1. Prohibits the state or any state agency or contractor for the state from sending its employees door-to-door to inquire about a person's vaccination status.
2. Becomes effective on the general effective date.
