(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Page 4, between lines 28 and 29, insert:

2 "Sec. 3. Section 32-1231, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 32-1231. Persons not required to be licensed

5 This chapter does not prohibit:

6 1. A dentist, dental therapist or dental hygienist who is officially  
7 employed in the service of the United States from practicing dentistry in  
8 the dentist's, dental therapist's or dental hygienist's official capacity,  
9 within the scope of that person's authority, on persons who are enlisted  
10 in, directly connected with or under the immediate control of some branch  
11 of service of the United States.

12 2. A person, whether or not licensed by this state, from practicing  
13 dental therapy either:

14 (a) In the discharge of official duties on behalf of the United  
15 States government, including the United States department of veterans  
16 affairs, the United States public health service and the Indian health  
17 service.

18 (b) While employed by tribal health programs authorized pursuant to  
19 Public Law 93-638 or urban Indian health programs.

20 3. An intern or student of dentistry, dental therapy or dental  
21 hygiene from operating in the clinical departments or laboratories of a  
22 recognized dental school, dental therapy school, dental hygiene school or  
23 hospital under the supervision of a dentist.

1           4. An unlicensed person from performing for a licensed dentist  
2 merely mechanical work on inert matter not within the oral cavity in the  
3 construction, making, alteration or repairing of any artificial dental  
4 substitute or any dental restorative or corrective appliance, if the casts  
5 or impressions for that work have been furnished by a licensed dentist and  
6 the work is directly supervised by the dentist for whom done or under a  
7 written authorization signed by the dentist, but the burden of proving that  
8 written authorization or direct supervision is on the person charged with  
9 having violated this provision.

10           5. A clinician who is not licensed in this state from giving  
11 demonstrations, before bona fide dental societies, study clubs and groups  
12 of professional students, that are free to the persons on whom made.

13           6. The state director of dental public health from performing the  
14 director's administrative duties as prescribed by law.

15           7. A dentist or dental hygienist to whom a restricted permit has  
16 been issued from practicing dentistry or dental hygiene in this state as  
17 provided in sections 32-1237 and 32-1292.

18           8. A dentist, dental therapist or dental hygienist ~~who is not~~  
19 ~~practicing on the public at large~~ from practicing ~~in~~ FOR EDUCATIONAL  
20 PURPOSES ON BEHALF OF a recognized dental school, recognized dental therapy  
21 school or recognized dental hygiene school."
