FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1. Appropriates \$38,482,000 in FY 2023 from the State Highway Fund to ADOT to rehabilitate pavement along U.S. Route 60 between Loop 101 and Loop 202, rather than between Tomahawk Road and Mile Post 208.**
- 2. Removes the \$19,327,300 appropriation to rehabilitate pavement along U.S. Route 66 between Ashfork and Seligman.**
- 3. Appropriates \$3,000,000 in FY 2023 from the state General Fund (GF) to the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) to improve Ruby Road bridge near Nogales.**
- 4. Exempts the \$3,000,000 appropriation from review by the Joint Committee on Capital Review (JCCR).**
- 5. Appropriates \$10,000,000 in FY 2023 from the state GF to ADOT to improve State Route 97 near Bagdad.**
- 6. Exempts the \$10,000,000 appropriation from review by JCCR.**
- 7. Makes conforming changes.**

16 "Sec. 18. Appropriation; department of transportation; State
17 Route 97 improvements; fiscal year 2023-2024;
18 exemption; lapsing

19 A. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the state general
20 fund in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the department of transportation to
21 improve State Route 97 near Bagdad.

22 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section reverts to
23 the state general fund on June 30, 2025 if the department does not secure
24 federal funding for the project on or before June 30, 2025.

1 C. Notwithstanding section 41-1252, Arizona Revised Statutes, the
2 appropriation made in subsection A of this section is not subject to review
3 by the joint committee on capital review.

4 D. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
5 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
6 to lapsing of appropriations, until June 30, 2025."
