AN ACT

REPEALING SECTIONS 41-2832 AND 41-2833, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES;
APPROPRIATING MONIES; RELATING TO COUNTY CONTRIBUTIONS FOR COMMITTED
YOUTH.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal; transfer of monies; appropriation

3 A. Sections 41-2832 and 41-2833, Arizona Revised Statutes, are
4 repealed.

5 B. All unexpended and unencumbered monies remaining in the
6 department of juvenile corrections local cost sharing fund established by
7 section 41-2833, Arizona Revised Statutes, as repealed by subsection A of
8 this section, are transferred to the state general fund on the effective
9 date of this section.

10 C. The total amount of monies transferred pursuant to subsection B
11 of this section is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year
12 2022-2023 to the department of administration to distribute to each county
13 in a proportional share using population data from the most recent United
14 States decennial census.
