**AN ACT**

**AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 36-407.02; RELATING TO HEALTH CARE INSTITUTIONS.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-407.02, to read:

4 36-407.02. Hospitals; family visitation

5 A HOSPITAL SHALL ALLOW A PATIENT TO HAVE DAILY IN-PERSON VISITATION  
6 BY THE PATIENT'S SPOUSE OR ONE PARENT OR CHILD OF THE PATIENT. A  
7 HOSPITAL'S POLICIES REGARDING VISITATION SHALL ENSURE THAT THE PATIENT AND  
8 THE PATIENT'S VISITORS MAY HAVE PHYSICAL CONTACT, ESPECIALLY DURING  
9 END-OF-LIFE VISITATION. THE PATIENT'S SPOUSE, PARENT OR CHILD WHO VISITS  
10 MUST COMPLY WITH REASONABLE HEALTH AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS IMPOSED BY THE  
11 HOSPITAL IN CONNECTION WITH THE VISIT.
