**AN ACT**

**AMENDING TITLE 18, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 7; RELATING TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.**

2 Section 1. Title 18, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 18-701. Artificial intelligence; requirements

8 A. AN ALGORITHM THAT ENABLES ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE TO LEARN AND  
9 IMPLEMENT DECISIONS WITHOUT HUMAN INTERVENTION MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING  
10 REQUIREMENTS:

- 11 1. SUPPORT HUMAN AGENCY AND FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS.
- 12 2. COMPLY WITH ALL FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS.
- 13 3. FULFILL ETHICAL PRINCIPLES THAT ENSURE NO UNINTENDED HUMAN HARM  
14 OCCURS.
- 15 4. PROVIDE TRANSPARENCY AND TRACEABILITY OF DATA LOGS AND  
16 DECISION-MAKING.

17 B. ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE MAY NOT INFRINGE ON A HUMAN BEING'S  
18 CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS.

19 Sec. 2. Legislative intent

20 The legislature intends by this act to protect citizens of this  
21 state from potential harm caused by algorithmic artificial intelligence  
22 designed to emulate human beings.
