AMENDING SECTION 41-1080.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO STATE
LICENSING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 41-1080.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:
4 41-1080.01. Licensing fees; waiver; appropriation;
5 definitions
6 A. Except for an individual who applies for a license pursuant to
7 title 36, chapter 4, article 10 or chapter 28.1, an agency shall waive any
8 fee charged for an initial license for ANY OF THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS IF
9 THE INDIVIDUAL IS APPLYING FOR THAT SPECIFIC LICENSE IN THIS STATE FOR THE
10 FIRST TIME:
11 1. Any individual applicant whose family income does not exceed two
12 hundred percent of the federal poverty guidelines ~~if the individual is~~
13 ~~applying for that specific license in this state for the first time.~~
14 2. ANY ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY SERVICE MEMBER'S SPOUSE.
15 3. ANY HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERAN WHO HAS BEEN DISCHARGED NOT
16 MORE THAN TWO YEARS BEFORE APPLICATION.
17 B. THE SUM OF \$300,000 IS APPROPRIATED FROM THE STATE GENERAL FUND
18 EACH FISCAL YEAR TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO REIMBURSE AN
19 AGENCY ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS FOR FEES THAT THE AGENCY WAIVED
20 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. AN AGENCY SHALL APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
21 ADMINISTRATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF FEES THAT THE AGENCY WAIVED PURSUANT
22 TO THIS SECTION.
23 ~~B.~~ C. For the purposes of this section, "agency" and "license"
24 have the same meanings prescribed in section 41-1080.
