AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 16-407.04; RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-407.04, to read:  
4 16-407.04. Voter lists; ballot images; cast vote record;  
5 ballot storage  
6 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW:  
7 1. THE COUNTY RECORDER SHALL PUBLISH TEN DAYS BEFORE THE PRIMARY  
8 AND GENERAL ELECTION A LIST OF ALL VOTERS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THE  
9 ELECTION, INCLUDING PERSONS WHO ARE ON THE INACTIVE VOTER LIST. THE  
10 COUNTY RECORDER SHALL POST THIS INFORMATION ON THE COUNTY RECORDER'S  
11 WEBSITE AND SHALL REDACT THE VOTER'S DATE OF BIRTH, DRIVER LICENSE NUMBER,  
12 NONOPERATING IDENTIFICATION LICENSE NUMBER AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR  
13 PORTION OF THAT NUMBER, AS APPLICABLE, BEFORE PUBLISHING OR POSTING THE  
14 LIST.  
15 2. AFTER THE PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTION AND FIVE DAYS BEFORE THE  
16 COUNTY CANVASS, THE COUNTY RECORDER OR OTHER OFFICER IN CHARGE OF  
17 ELECTIONS SHALL PUBLISH AND POST IN DIGITAL FORMAT ON THE COUNTY'S WEBSITE  
18 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:  
19 (a) A LIST OF ALL PERSONS WHO VOTED AND THEIR METHOD OF VOTING.  
20 (b) ALL BALLOT IMAGES WITH THE UNIQUE IDENTIFYING NUMBER FROM THE  
21 BALLOT.  
22 (c) THE CAST VOTE RECORD IN A SORTABLE FORMAT.  
23 3. EARLY AND PROVISIONAL BALLOT TABULATORS SHALL IMPRINT A UNIQUE  
24 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER ON EACH EARLY BALLOT TABULATED SO AS TO ALLOW THE  
25 BALLOT IMAGE TO BE LINKED TO THE PHYSICAL BALLOT. EARLY AND PROVISIONAL  
26 BALLOTS SHALL BE SEPARATED BY PRECINCT, TABULATED AND STORED BY PRECINCT.  
27 ELECTION DAY BALLOTS ALSO SHALL BE STORED BY PRECINCT AFTER TABULATION.  
28 4. THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF ELECTIONS SHALL ENSURE THAT PAPER  
29 BALLOTS ARE SORTED AND STORED IN A MANNER THAT ALLOWS FOR CONVENIENT  
30 RETRIEVAL.
