SENATE BILL 1182

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-1509, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE
ARIZONA COMMERCE AUTHORITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1509, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-1509. Career landscape information collection;
5 distribution; posting; definitions

6 A. The authority shall annually collect and compile all of the
7 following information:

8 1. The most in-demand jobs in this state, including the starting
9 salary, ~~and~~ required education level AND ESTIMATED NUMBER OF POSITIONS
10 AVAILABLE for each of these jobs.

11 2. The average cost to attend each of the following:

12 (a) Each university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of
13 regents.

14 (b) Community colleges.

15 (c) Vocational programs as data is readily available through the
16 ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

17 (d) Private postsecondary institutions as data is readily available
18 through the ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

19 3. The lowest to highest median monthly student loan payment among
20 undergraduate fields of study for individuals who attended each of the
21 following:

22 (a) Each university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of
23 regents.

24 (b) Community colleges.

25 (c) Vocational programs as data is readily available through the
26 ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

27 (d) Private postsecondary institutions as data is readily available
28 through the ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

29 4. The three-year student loan default rate of individuals who
30 attended each of the following:

31 (a) Each university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of
32 regents.

33 (b) Community colleges.

34 (c) Vocational programs as data is readily available through the
35 ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

36 (d) Private postsecondary institutions as data is readily available
37 through the ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

38 5. The graduation rate for each of the following:

39 (a) Each university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of
40 regents.

41 (b) Community colleges.

42 (c) Vocational programs as data is readily available through the
43 ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

44 (d) Private postsecondary institutions as data is readily available
45 through the ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

1 6. The completion rates for all of the following:

2 (a) Department of economic security-approved and United States
3 department of labor-approved apprenticeship programs, as collected by the
4 department of economic security.

5 (b) High school equivalency programs in this state.

6 (c) Career and technical education programs.

7 7. The lowest to highest median starting earnings among
8 undergraduate fields of study for individuals who graduated from each of
9 the following:

10 (a) Each university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of
11 regents.

12 (b) Community colleges.

13 (c) Vocational programs as data is readily available through the
14 ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

15 (d) Private postsecondary institutions as data is readily available
16 through the ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of education.

17 B. Not later than December 1 of each year, the authority shall
18 transmit the information collected and compiled pursuant to subsection A
19 of this section to each public high school in this state to distribute to
20 students.

21 C. All state agencies, universities under the jurisdiction of the
22 Arizona board of regents, community colleges, vocational programs and
23 private postsecondary institutions shall provide data, reports and other
24 information as requested by the authority to fulfill the requirements of
25 this section.

26 D. Not later than October 1 of each year, all state agencies,
27 universities under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of regents,
28 community colleges, vocational programs and private postsecondary
29 institutions shall provide the data, reports and other information
30 necessary to fulfill the requirements of this section to the authority.

31 E. The authority shall make the information collected and compiled
32 pursuant to subsection A of this section publicly available and shall post
33 this information on its website.

34 F. For the purposes of this section:

35 1. "Community college" has the same meaning prescribed in section
36 15-1401.

37 2. "Vocational program" has the same meaning prescribed in section
38 15-1831.
