AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-151, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SCHOOL SAFETY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-151, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 15-151. Protective eyewear; definition

5 A. Every student, teacher and visitor in public and private  
6 schools, community colleges, colleges and universities shall wear  
7 appropriate ~~eye~~ protective ~~ware~~ EYEWEAR while participating in or when  
8 observing vocational, technical, industrial arts, art or laboratory  
9 science activities involving exposure to:

- 10 1. Molten metals or other molten materials.
- 11 2. Cutting, shaping and grinding of materials.
- 12 3. Heat treatment, tempering or kiln firing of any metal or other  
13 materials.
- 14 4. Welding fabrication processes.
- 15 5. Explosive materials.
- 16 6. Caustic solutions.
- 17 7. Radioactive materials.

18 B. The governing board of every school district, the governing  
19 board of every community college district, the Arizona board of regents  
20 and every person maintaining a private or parochial school in this state  
21 shall equip schools within their jurisdiction with ~~eye~~ protective ~~ware~~  
22 EYEWEAR for use as required in this article.

23 C. Standards and rules for the enforcement of this article shall be  
24 prescribed by the governing board of every school district, the community  
25 college district governing board of each community college district and  
26 the Arizona board of regents.

27 D. Schools, community colleges, colleges and universities may  
28 receive and expend federal, state and local monies to provide ~~eye~~  
29 protective ~~devices~~ EYEWEAR.

30 E. For purposes of this article, "~~eye~~ protective ~~wear~~ EYEWEAR"  
31 means devices meeting the ~~standards of the~~ American national standards  
32 institute's standards for occupational and education eye protection,  
33 Z87.1-1989.
