1 Page 1, line 18, after "ORDERED" insert "BY A LICENSED MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL"

2 Line 39, strike "OR" insert ", PRESCRIBED,"; after "RECOMMENDED" insert "OR
3 ORDERED BY A LICENSED MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL"

4 Page 2, line 23, after "ANY" insert "MEDICAL OR PSYCHIATRIC"

5 Line 34, strike "AT LEAST"

6 After line 46, insert:

7 "Sec. 2. Appropriations; report; exemption; delayed repeal

8 A. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
9 in each of fiscal years 2022-2023, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 to the Arizona
10 health care cost containment system administration for enhanced treatment
11 services ordered pursuant to section 36-540.03, Arizona Revised Statutes,
12 as added by this act.

13 B. On or before January 1, 2026, the Arizona health care cost
14 containment system administration shall provide a report to the governor,
15 the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives
16 and shall provide a copy of the report to the secretary of state that
17 includes information regarding all of the following for the three prior
18 fiscal years:

19 1. Denials for requests for housing based on unavailability of
20 housing.

21 2. Denials for enhanced treatment services as ordered by the court
22 based on unavailability of funding for the services.

23 3. Denials for enhanced treatment services as ordered by the court
24 based on unavailability of the treatment services.

1 4. Costs associated with providing enhanced treatment services as
2 ordered by the court by individual and by service type.

3 C. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are
4 exempt from the provisions of section 35-190 relating to lapsing of
5 appropriations.

6 D. This section is repealed from and after June 30, 2026."
