1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:
3 1. Article IV, part 2, section 2, Constitution of Arizona, is
4 proposed to be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on
5 proclamation of the Governor:
6 2. Qualifications of members of legislature
7 Section 2. No person shall be a member of the
8 Legislature unless ~~he shall be~~ THE PERSON IS a citizen of the
9 United States at the time of ~~his~~ election, ~~nor unless he shall~~
10 ~~be~~ IS at least ~~twenty-five~~ EIGHTEEN years of age, and ~~shall~~
11 ~~have~~ HAS been a resident of Arizona FOR at least three
12 CONSECUTIVE years AT THE TIME OF ELECTION and of the ~~county~~
13 DISTRICT from which ~~he is~~ elected FOR at least one CONSECUTIVE
14 year ~~before his~~ AT THE TIME OF election.
15 2. Short title
16 This act may be cited as the "Arizona Civic Participation Act".
17 3. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
18 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
19 Constitution of Arizona.
