1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 7, article 4, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-773.01, to read:

4 15-773.01. Parental rights; children with disabilities; body
5 camera

6 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE PARENT OF A CHILD WITH A
7 DISABILITY MAY USE A BODY CAMERA THAT THE PARENT HARNESSSES TO THE CHEST OF
8 THE CHILD WITH A DISABILITY TO ENSURE THAT THE CHILD WITH A DISABILITY IS
9 PROPERLY TREATED AND IS SAFE AND HEALTHY WHILE AT SCHOOL.
