AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 6-129.02; RELATING TO RECORDS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 6, chapter 1, article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 6-129.02, to read:

4 6-129.02. Records destruction; personal information

5 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED BY AN
6 APPLICABLE LAW THAT REQUIRES A RETENTION PERIOD THAT EXCEEDS TEN YEARS, A
7 BANK OR FINANCIAL INSTITUTION SHALL DESTROY, IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY
8 LAW, ALL PERSONAL INFORMATION BELONGING TO A FORMER CUSTOMER OR CLIENT NOT
9 LATER THAN TEN YEARS AFTER THE BUSINESS RELATIONSHIP ENDS.
