#### FACT SHEET FOR S.B. 1006

## municipal notices and ordinances; posting

## **Purpose**

Includes a city's or town's website as a statutorily authorized location for publishing notices of election, invitations for bids, notices of letting contracts, laws and ordinances and other notices (municipal notices and ordinances). Requires a link to all current notices and ordinances to be listed on the website's home page.

### **Background**

Municipal notices and ordinances issued by the governing body of any city or town must be published in a newspaper that is either printed and published within the city or town or printed and published within the county in which the city or town is located and has a greater circulation to residents (A.R.S. § 9-812).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the state General Fund associated with this legislation.

#### **Provisions**

- 1. Includes a city's or town's website as a statutorily authorized location for publishing municipal notices and ordinances.
- 2. Requires a city or town that posts municipal notices and ordinances on the city's or town's website to provide a link to a listing of all current notices and ordinances on the website's home page.
- 3. Makes technical and conforming changes.
- 4. Becomes effective on the general effective date.
